STEPHEN SWORD HAS just lifted the British Motocross Championship, and this year it was aboard this bike. This year's bike has a couple of minor changes to the engine but basically remains the same. It benefits from a straighter exhaust port for improved throttle response.



KX250

THE original bad-boy two-stroke. Kawasaki's KX250 has scared more wannabe dirt experts than anything else.

For this year, the engine has a redesigned cylinder which has been repositioned to allow a

longer exhaust port, steering has been sharpened with a decrease in rake while the frame is now slimmer with higher footpegs for added ground clearance.



KX125

THE 125 hasn't changed a great deal. It has shed some weight by using lighter fork materials on the fork and parts of the engine have been revised.
